Our Refund Policy

- At this time members and Learn to Curlers who have paid can request a full refund if they are not going to join.
- For those remaining to play the half season they may request a refund for the paid-up, unplayed portion of the season or put the balance towards the following season.
- If play begins in January, we will pro-rate refunds if the season is shortened due to government order or other unforeseen circumstances.
